DAY 3, Mon, Jan 26 BUENOS AIRES/SAIL

We have the day at leisure until we depart for the pier where we board the Royal Princess. We have time to settle into our comfortable cabins and unpack before we sail this evening. (B, meals aboard ship)

DAY 4, Tue, Jan 27 (7 a.m./2 p.m.) MONTEVIDEO, URUGUAY

Uruguay's capital and only large city, Montevideo is a popular vacation spot for many South Americans, with white sandy beaches and a relaxed atmosphere. Be sure to check out the Mercado del Puerto or one of the estancias in the countryside surrounding the city. (B,L,D)

DAY 5, Wed, Jan 28 AT SEA

This day gives you an opportunity to take advantage of the many amenities aboard your ship. Enjoy the swimming pools and hot tubs. Jog the track. Or workout in the fitness center. Spoil yourself at the exclusive spa on board. Play cards. Bid at the art auction. Shop for souvenirs. Relax on deck. Or just enjoy the view. Do it all. Or do nothing. It's always up to you! (B,L,D)

DAY 6, Thu, Jan 29 (6:00 a.m./5:00 p.m.) PUERTO MADRYN, ARGENTINA

Founded by Welsh settlers in 1865, Puerto Madryn is the place to start if you want to see numerous sea lions, elephant seals and penguins on the beaches of nearby Valdes Peninsula. (B,L,D)

DAY 7, Fri, Jan 30 AT SEA

Today you may want to take part in a lecture, visit the Internet Cafe, try the computerized golf center and putting

green, or participate in other activities on board. (B,L,D)

DAY 8, Sat, Jan 31 (7 a.m./4 p.m.) STANLEY, FALKLAND ISLANDS

The capital of the Falkland Islands is decidedly British in nature. Take a tour of the island, or in good weather, explore the 19th Century sailing ships and wrecks abandoned over the years. (B,L,D)

DAY 9, Sun, Feb 1 CRUISE CAPE HORN

Rounding the extreme southern tip of South America, you'll be awe-struck by the rugged beauty and imposing vision of Cape Horn, a craggy, massive rocky point that was the bane of early explorers. (B,L,D)

DAY 10, Mon, Feb 2 (5:00 a.m./1:45 p.m.) USHUAIA, ARGENTINA/(3:45-6:45 p.m.) CRUISE BEAGLE CHANNEL

The "town at the end of the world," Ushuaia is the last stop before the frozen continent of Antarctica. Bathed in an amazing light, Ushuaia offers breathtaking walks through Tierra del Fuego National Park. Host to the southernmost city in the world, Puerto Williams, this jagged, winding waterway (Beagle Channel) is home to a multitude of sea wolf species. Weathered red-and-white-striped lighthouses dot the sea-side terrain. (B,L,D)

DAY 11, Tue, Feb 3 (8 a.m./17 p.m.) PUNTA ARENAS, CHILE

The only city on the Strait of Magellan, Punta Arenas is an important export center for Patagonia wool. The Patagonia Institute, an open-air museum with artifacts from early settlers, is a must-see. (B,L,D)

DAY 12, Wed, Feb 4 AT SEA

This day you could visit the duty-free boutiques. Princess' exclusive onboard shops offer a wide selection of jewelry, apparel, fine gifts, fragrances and souvenirs. (B,L,D)

DAY 13, Thu, Feb 5 (7:00 a.m./3:00 p.m.) SENO EYRE FJORD

Lying on Chile's beautiful stretch of southern coastline, Seno Eyre Fjord is a deep valley terraced by rich jungle greenery. You'll be astounded by the vistas, from the Strait of Magellan to Puerto Montt. (B,L,D)

DAY 14, Fri, Feb 6 AT SEA

Another day at leisure to relax and enjoy shipboard activities. (B,L,D)



DAY 15, Sat, Feb 7 (7:00 a.m./6:00 p.m.) PUERTO MONTT, CHILE

Featuring Central European architecture with high-pitched roofs and balconies, this important city in southern Chile will remind you of a Bavarian village. (B,L,D)

DAY 16, Sun, Feb 8 AT SEA

Perhaps today you will join a special interest group. Or maybe spend the day on deck, soaking up the sun's rays.(B,L,D)

DAY 17, Mon, Feb 9 SANTIAGO (VALPARAISO), CHILE

After arrival in port, we enjoy a city tour as we transfer to the Carrera Hotel. Founded in 1541, this richly cultural Chilean city features views of the majestic Andes Mountains from almost anywhere within its borders. We have the balance of the day at leisure. (B)

DAY 18, Tue, Feb 10 SANTIAGO/DALLAS

We have this day at leisure and then transfer to the airport this evening where we begin our journey back home. (B, meals aloft)

DAY 19, Wed, Feb 11

We arrive home in early afternoon.

Terms and Conditions

PAYMENT: A deposit is required for booking. Full payment is due 120 days prior to departure.

AIR ARRANGEMENTS: Unless otherwise specified, airfare and air taxes are not included in the cruise price. The cruise line offers low air fare add-ons from most major U.S. cities, which Dehoney Travel will compare to other options to ensure the best available schedule/price.

NOT INCLUDED IN CRUISE PRICE: Airfare & air taxes (unless otherwise specified); gratuities; government fees; single supplement; shore excursions; excess baggage and forwarding of baggage; Travel Protection Plan; passport; personal items such as laundry or tips for personal favors; any cost resulting from absence or deviation from the itinerary; meals not listed as being included; items of a personal nature; and any other item not shown herein as being included.

MEALS: All meals are included on the cruise. Meals as listed for any pre- or post-cruise arrangements. B = breakfast; L = lunch; D = dinner.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTATION: A current passport is required for this cruise.

CHANGES: A \$50 service fee will be charged for changes made to existing tours within 45 days of departure. Changes of departure date or tour are considered a cancellation and a new booking. The service fee will not be assessed when upgrading cruise accommodations.

CANCELLATION: In event of cancellation, there will be a fee of \$75 for Dehoney Travel, Inc. to cover administrative costs. In addition, without protection as outlined below, cancellation fees will be charged by the cruise line. Cancellation penalties are as follows: after booking-121 days prior to departure, \$75 administrative fee; 120-91 days prior to departure will be charged the amount of deposit; within 90-51 days prior, 50% of the total tour cost (including air add-on and tax) will be assessed; within 50-31 days prior, 75% of the total tour cost (including air add-on and tax) will be assessed. Within 30 days to day of departure/no show, entire tour cost is non-refundable. Any trip interruption due to illness, accident or family emergency is subject to 100% of the unused balance of the total tour cost. Cancellation notification must be made in writing to Dehoney Travel. Please allow up to four weeks for cancellation refund processing.

AIR TICKETS: Air tickets will be subject to cancellation/re-booking penalties. The cost of any cancellation or changes made once the ticket has been issued will be charged to the passenger. Special requests are subject to a deviation fee by the air department. After ticketing of international air, a cancellation penalty of 100% of the air fare is in effect. On or after the date of departure there can be no refund for any service not used.

The cruise line reserves the right to cancel any scheduled tour prior to departure. In the event that this should occur after final payment has been received by the cruise line, all payments will be refunded in full. The cruise line reserves the right to use alternate means of transportation when tour passenger numbers warrant such substitution and also reserves the right to change show performances when not available.

TRAVEL PROTECTION PLAN: As many U.S. health carriers do not provide benefits while outside the country and cancellation penalties can be substantial for many tours, Dehoney Travel, Inc. offers a Travel Protection Plan, TripCare, through Access America. The Option to Waive Pre-existing Condition requires purchase of Travel Protection within 14 days of deposit. You may decline the Travel Protection Plan, but a signed disclaimer is required and all cancellation charges are your responsibility.
