Day by Day Itinerary

DAY 1 HOMETOWN/HONOLULU

Flight from the mainland to Honolulu where we are met with the traditional fresh flower lei on arrival and assisted to baggage claim. Our Tour Director will guide us to our motorcoach and we will be transferred to Aloha Tower Pier to board the ***Pride of America*** or the ***Pride of Hawaii***, where we have opportunity to acquaint ourselves with the facilities we will enjoy for the next seven days! We have time to settle into our comfortable cabins and unpack for the week before we sail about 8 p.m.

DAY 2 HILO, HAWAII

Gaze up from this charming town and see snow-capped Mauna Kea volcano. It's just one of the scenic marvels in this exotic greenhouse of lush tropical plants, towering banyan trees, thundering falls and enough flowers to fill a rainbow. Arid deserts, steaming fissures and volcanoes that blow their tops are just as impressive. This evening we sail by Mount Kilauea.

DAY 3 KAHULUI, MAUI

Visit the Iao Valley and see the famed Iao Valley Needle, a 2,250-foot lava rock that pierces the clouds. Visit the Tropical Plantation and take a tram ride through 60 acres of commercial fruit crops including sugarcane, mango, coffee, flowering ginger and more. Afterward, walk through their nursery and visit the agricultural village with its fascinating displays.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AIR ARRANGEMENTS: Add-on airfare from countless destinations across the U.S. and Canada are available. Just let us know which "hometown" airport you prefer.

NOT INCLUDED: Port charges , government taxes, shore excursions, Travel Protection Program, tips while aboard ship, passport fees, items of personal nature, etc.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All United States and Canada citizens must carry a valid passport as proof of citizenship.

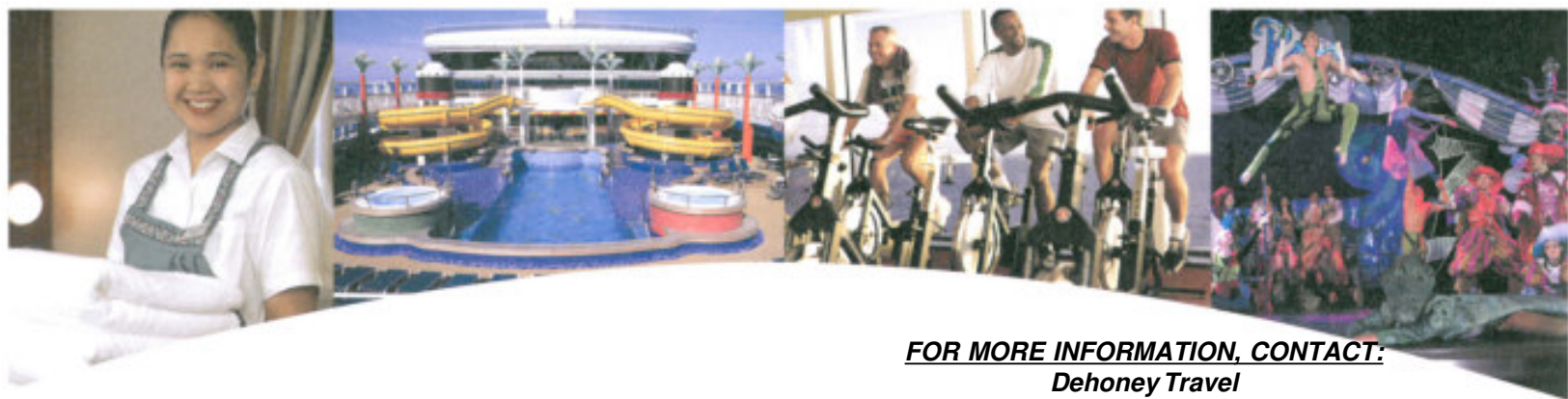
PAYMENT: Payment can be made by cash, check or credit card (Discover, MasterCard or Visa). A deposit for each person is required at the time of booking. Final payment is due upon receipt of final invoice (approximately 12 weeks prior to departure).

CANCELLATION: In event of cancellation, there will be a fee of \$75 for Dehoney Travel, Inc. to cover administrative costs. In addition, without protection as outlined on the following page, cancellation fees **will be charged**. Cancellation penalties are as follows: after booking until 186 days prior to tour, \$75 administrative fee; 185-51 days prior to tour, amount of deposit; 50-13 days prior to tour, 75% of total tour cost; 12 days prior to tour-day of departure/ no show, tour cost is non-refundable. **All cancellation notifications must be made in writing to Dehoney Travel, Inc. Please allow 4 weeks for cancellation refund processing.**

After ticketing of air fare, a cancellation penalty of 100% of the air fare is in effect. On or after the date of departure there can be no refund for any service not used.

TRAVEL PROTECTION PLAN: As many U.S. health carriers do not provide benefits while outside the mainland and cancellation penalties can be substantial





for many tours, Dehoney Travel recommends the purchase of NCL Travel Care travel protection. In order to maximize the value of your coverage, we recommend this purchase be made at time of deposit. **You may decline the Travel Protection Plan. To do so, a signed disclaimer is required and all cancellation charges are your responsibility.**

CANCELLATION, DELAY OR DEVIATION OF CRUISE: Carrier may at any time, without notice, delay, change or cancel the cruise or Commencement date, deny Passenger a stateroom or substitute vessels, even if Passenger has a confirmed or guaranteed reservation, and Passenger shall have no claim against Carrier/Dehoney Travel, Inc. for any resulting hotel, food, travel or other expenses, delay, inconvenience or damages whatsoever, other than reimbursement of unearned cruise/vacation package fare. This reimbursement discharges Carrier/DTI from all liability. If, after sailing, the cruise is interrupted by a fortuitous event, Act of God or any other cause for which neither the Carrier/Dehoney Travel, Inc. nor the Passenger is responsible, or the ship is or will be unduly delayed or prevented from proceeding in the ordinary course, Carrier shall have the right to terminate the ship's cruise, and refund the unearned cruise/vacation package fare. In all such cases, unless otherwise stated herein, the Passenger shall not be entitled to any refund of fare or compensation of any kind and shall have no other claim against the Carrier/Dehoney Travel, Inc. In all situations the ship may tow and assist vessels and deviate from the advertised route and call on or omit calling on any port or place for any reason or purpose which, in the Carrier's judgment, is reasonable under existing circumstances, and to comply with all orders given by governmental authorities, the underwriters of the ship or the Carrier. Passenger shall have no claim whatsoever against Carrier/Dehoney Travel, Inc. in such circumstances.
