**Optional Pre-cruise tour to Cuzco and Machu Picchu**

**Day 1 - Hometown/Lima.** Upon arrival, transfer to the **Lima Marriott** for overnight. (meals aloft)

**Day 2 - Enjoy a half-day city tour** of the colonial and modern parts of Lima. Overnight at our hotel. (B)

**Day 3 - After a buffet breakfast at the hotel, transfer to the airport for flight to Cuzco; half day city tour** includes visit of ruins Puca Pucara, Tambo Machay, Kenko and Sacsayhuaman. **Dinner with folklore show** at Tunupa restaurant, located in front of the Main Square of Cuzco and within walking distance of our hotel. Overnight at the **Libertador Cuzco**. (B,D)

**Day 4 - Full day excursion to Machu Picchu**, the number one attraction in South America. We board a train in Cuzco, and then near Machu Picchu we transfer to a bus which takes us the rest of the way to the top. Two thousand feet above the rumbling Urubamba river, the cloud-shrouded ruins have palaces, baths, temples, storage rooms and some 150 houses, all in a remarkable state of preservation. Dinner and overnight at our hotel. (B,L,D)

**Day 5 - Morning transfer to the airport for our flight to Lima and then to the pier in Callao for boarding the Regal Princess.** (B,D)

**Beginning of standard program, March 12**

**Day 1 - Hometown/Lima.** Upon arrival, transfer to the **Lima Marriott** for overnight. (meals aloft)

**Day 2 - Lima, Peru - board the Regal Princess**

Feel the power of the ages in a golden city where pre-Columbian heritage and Spanish colonial architecture create a grand display. Transfer to the pier to board the *Regal Princess* for our Pacific to Atlantic Panama Canal cruise. (B,D)

**Day 3 - Lima, Peru - cruise departs at noon** (B,L,D)

**Day 4 - At Sea**

Participate in your choice of on-board activities: browse the world-class art collection, shop in duty-free boutiques, relax in a hot tub, sun yourself on the deck with a book from the ship's library, exercise in a state-of-the-art gym, or pamper yourself in the spa; and at mealtimes take advantage of the ship's variety of dining options. (B,L,D)

**Day 5 - Manta, Ecuador, 7 a.m./7 p.m.**

Take an optional excursion flight from Manta to Quito, the second-highest capital in the world. In Quito, nestled at the base of Pichincha Volcano, you may view a wealth of Spanish colonial architecture and tour the Monastery of San Francisco, Ecuador's oldest. Or, choose an excursion that explores the archaeological museum in Manta, Montecristi - the birthplace of the Panama hat, and the Ivory Nut Factory where artisans carve figurines and jewelry. (B,L,D)

**Day 6 - At Sea.** On-board activities. (B,L,D)

**Day 7 - Puntarenas, Costa Rica, 7 a.m./7 p.m.**

You may choose an optional trip rafting down the Corobici River or traveling on the Pan American Highway from the gateway city of Puntarenas to Costa Rica's historic capital, San Jose. Or, make a visit to the spectacular Monteverde Cloud Forest reserve. (B,L,D)



**Day 8 - At Sea.** On-board activities.

**Day 9 - Panama Canal/Gatun Lake, 7 a.m./3:30 p.m.**

Imagine being raised and lowered a total of 26 meters through the three massive sets of locks of the Panama Canal utilizing only the power of gravity, a concept so simple yet profound it has stood the test of time. The canal's construction occurred over a period of 34 years and was costly in terms of human life with an estimated 27,500 deaths as a result of building the canal. Many of those deaths were due to yellow fever and malaria. Water for the locks (around 52 million gallons per transit) is supplied by Gatun Lake, an immense artificial reservoir of 168 square miles. Surrounded by lush, impenetrable jungle, it is one of the most scenic portions of a Canal transit.

**Colon, Panama (Cristobal) - 4 p.m./8 p.m.**

This thriving hub of international trade provides the perfect gateway for setting out on a variety of fascinating shore excursions. Take a nature walk through a rain forest, or get an up-close look at the workings of the Panama Canal's locks. (B,L,D)

**Day 10 - At Sea.** On-board activities.

**Day 11 - Aruba, 8 a.m./5 p.m.**

This island gem sparkles with an abundance of pristine beaches and natural reefs as it welcomes travelers in search of sun and solitude. Optional activities include snorkeling, diving, golfing or horseback-riding along its rugged surf-carved rocks and crystal-blue seas. (B,L,D)

**Day 12 - At Sea.** On-board activities.

**Day 13 - St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands, 7 a.m./6 p.m.**

You may choose an optional excursion to explore St. Thomas from underwater with a helmet dive at Coral World or a submarine dive near Buck Island; or instead decide to play golf at Mahogany Run, a magnificent 18-hole, par-70 course. (B,L,D)

**Day 14 - San Juan, Puerto Rico, 7 a.m.**

Originally built as a fortress, San Juan is rich with Spanish tradition. It's also the second oldest city in the Americas. Upon arrival at the pier, we are transferred to the **Sheraton Old San Juan Hotel**. The remainder of the day is at leisure. (B)

**Day 15 - San Juan/Hometown** - This morning we are transferred to the airport for our return flight to the States. (B,meals aloft)

## Terms and Conditions

**PAYMENT:** A deposit is required for booking. Full payment is due 120 days prior to departure.

**AIR ARRANGEMENTS:** Unless otherwise specified, airfare and air taxes are not included in the cruise price. The cruise line offers low air fare add-ons from most major U.S. cities, which Dehoney Travel will compare to other options to ensure the best available schedule/price.

**NOT INCLUDED IN CRUISE PRICE:** Airfare & air taxes (unless otherwise specified); gratuities; government fees; single supplement; shore excursions; excess baggage and forwarding of baggage; Travel Protection Plan; passport; personal items such as laundry or tips for personal favors; any cost resulting from absence or deviation from the itinerary; meals not listed as being included; items of a personal nature; and any other item not shown herein as being included.

**MEALS:** All meals are included on the cruise. Meals as listed for any pre- or post-cruise arrangements. B = breakfast; L = lunch; D = dinner.

**TRAVEL DOCUMENTATION:** A current passport is required for this cruise.

**CHANGES:** A \$50 service fee will be charged for changes made to existing tours within 45 days of departure. Changes of departure date or tour are considered a cancellation and a new booking. The service fee will not be assessed when upgrading cruise accommodations.

**CANCELLATION:** In event of cancellation, there will be a fee of \$75 for Dehoney Travel, Inc. to cover administrative costs. In addition, without protection as outlined below, cancellation fees will be charged by the cruise line. Cancellation penalties are as follows: after booking-121 days prior to departure, \$75 administrative fee; 120-91 days prior to departure will be charged the amount of deposit; within 90-51 days prior, 50% of the total tour cost (including air add-on and tax) will be assessed; within 50-31 days prior, 75% of the total tour cost (including air add-on and tax) will be assessed. Within 30 days to day of departure/no show, entire tour cost is non-refundable. Any trip interruption due to illness, accident or family emergency is subject to 100% of the unused balance of the total tour cost. **Cancellation notification must be made in writing to Dehoney Travel. Please allow up to four weeks for cancellation refund processing.**

**AIR TICKETS:** Air tickets will be subject to cancellation/re-booking penalties. The cost of any cancellation or changes made once the ticket has been issued will be charged to the passenger. Special requests are subject to a deviation fee by the air department. **After ticketing of international air, a cancellation penalty of 100% of the air fare is in effect. On or after the date of departure there can be no refund for any service not used.**

The cruise line reserves the right to cancel any scheduled tour prior to departure. In the event that this should occur after final payment has been received by the cruise line, all payments will be

refunded in full. The cruise line reserves the right to use alternate means of transportation when tour passenger numbers warrant such substitution and also reserves the right to change show performances when not available.

**TRAVEL PROTECTION PLAN:** As many U.S. health carriers do not provide benefits while outside the country and cancellation penalties can be substantial for many tours, Dehoney Travel, Inc. offers a Travel Protection Plan, TripCare, through Access America. **The Option to Waive Pre-existing Condition requires purchase of Travel Protection within 14 days of deposit.
