DAILY ITINERARY

1st Day, Mon, Aug 8 - Vancouver (embark p.m.)

Travel to Vancouver and transfer to the *Dawn Princess* for our departure later in the evening. (D)

2nd Day, Tue, Aug 9 - Inside Passage

Relax in the luxurious surroundings of our Princess ship as we cruise through the 1,000-mile-long inland waterway of the Inside Passage. Be sure to keep watch for wildlife and native fishing villages as you enjoy the views of this magnificent waterway. There's plenty to do on a Princess ship; check the daily newsletter for scheduled activities. (B,L,D)

3rd Day, Wed, Aug 10 - Ketchikan (6:30 a.m./2:30 p.m.)

Established in 1887 as an Indian fishing camp, Ketchikan is now an important mining, logging and fishing town, known as the Salmon Capital of the World. Be sure to go ashore, maybe inspect the excellent display of native Alaskan art and artifacts at the Tongass Historical Society Museum or take an optional tour to Saxman Village to watch native carvers at work. (B,L,D)

4th Day, Thu, Aug 11 - Juneau (7:00 a.m./7:30 p.m.)

We make a stop at Alaska's capital, the first city founded in Alaska after the American purchase in 1867. Explore on your own, or shop for native crafts and gold nuggets. Take an optional tour to the U.S. Forest Service Observatory and Visitor Center for a close-up look at the mighty Mendenhall Glacier. On the way back to town visit the Chapel by the Lake, a little log church with a truly inspirational view of Auke Lake and Mendenhall Glacier. (B,L,D)

5th Day, Fri, Aug 12 - Skagway (7:00 a.m./8:00 p.m.)

Skagway, at the north end of the Lynn Canal, is the gateway to Gold Rush Country and the heart of the Klondike National Park. It was a mighty lively place in the Days of '98 and still is -- and it looks much the same, with worn boardwalks, false-fronted buildings, old-time saloons. A good way to catch the flavor is to drop in on the hilarious "Days of '98" show. (This is an optional activity.) Or, you may want to take a ride on the narrow-gauge White Pass & Yukon Route railroad. (B,L,D)

6th Day, Sat, Aug 13 - Glacier Bay

Today we'll enjoy more spectacular glacial views as we cruise through pristine Glacier Bay National Park. Keep your camera handy! (B,L,D)

7th Day, Sun, Aug 14 - College Fjord Cruising

Sailing into College Fjord is like entering nature's own Ice Age showroom, with 16 gleaming glaciers cascading down to the sea. Here we can see up to six glaciers at once - with names such as Harvard, Yale, Dartmouth, and Radcliffe - all names for the colleges that supported the Harriman Expedition leading to their discovery in 1889. (B,L,D)

8th Day, Mon, Aug 15 - Whittier/Hometown

We disembark in the small town of Whittier and transfer to the Anchorage airport for our flight home. (B)

Terms and Conditions

PAYMENT: A deposit is required for booking. Full payment is due 120 days prior to departure.

AIR ARRANGEMENTS: Unless otherwise specified, airfare and air taxes are not included in the cruise price. The cruise line offers low airfare add-ons from most major U.S. cities, which Dehoney Travel will compare to other options to ensure the best available schedule/price.

NOT INCLUDED IN CRUISE PRICE: Airfare & air taxes (unless otherwise specified); gratuities; government fees; single supplement; shore excursions; excess baggage and forwarding of baggage; Travel Protection Plan; passport; personal items such as laundry or tips for personal favors; any cost resulting from absence or deviation from the itinerary; meals not listed as being included; items of a personal nature; and any other item not shown herein as being included.

MEALS: All meals are included on the cruise. Meals as listed for any pre- or post-cruise arrangements. B = breakfast; L = lunch; D = dinner.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTATION: A current passport is required for this cruise.

CHANGES: A \$50 service fee will be charged for changes made to existing tours within 45 days of departure. Changes of departure date or tour are considered a cancellation and a new booking. The service fee will not be assessed when upgrading cruise accommodations.

CANCELLATION: In event of cancellation, there will be a fee of \$75 for Dehoney Travel, Inc. to cover administrative costs. In addition, without protection as outlined below, cancellation fees will be charged by the cruise line. Cancellation penalties are as follows: after booking-121 days prior to departure, \$75 administrative fee; 120-91 days prior to departure will be charged the amount of deposit; within 90-51 days prior, 50% of the total tour cost (including air add-on and tax) will be assessed; within 50-31 days prior, 75% of the total tour cost (including air add-on and tax) will be assessed. Within 30 days to day of departure/no show, entire tour cost is non-refundable. Any

trip interruption due to illness, accident or family emergency is subject to 100% of the unused balance of the total tour cost. Cancellation notification must be made in writing to Dehoney Travel. **Please allow up to four weeks for cancellation refund processing.**

AIR TICKETS: Air tickets will be subject to cancellation/re-booking penalties. The cost of any cancellation or changes made once the ticket has been issued will be charged to the passenger. Special requests are subject to a deviation fee by the air department. After ticketing of international air, a cancellation penalty of 100% of the air fare is in effect. On or after the date of departure there can be no refund for any service not used.

The cruise line reserves the right to cancel any scheduled tour prior to departure. In the event that this should occur after final payment has been received by the cruise line, all payments will be refunded in full. The cruise line reserves the right to use alternate means of transportation when tour passenger numbers warrant such substitution and also reserves the right to change show performances when not available.
