There are museums to visit and wonderful shopping from Harrods and Marks & Spencer to open-air markets. Explore London's infinitely diverse neighborhoods: Hyde Park and Downing Street, Piccadilly Circus and Trafalgar Square. There are more parks and greenbelts here than in almost any other city in the world, along with a cache of grand museums, noble monuments and magnificent architecture, a holdover from a time when this tiny island ruled a considerable portion of the globe. As Henry James said with his typically dry English-style humor: "London is on the whole the most possible form of life." Prior to the cruise, spend two nights in London, touring Windsor Castle and its grounds, and having time at leisure to take in all that London has to offer, before proceeding to the port of Dover to board the *Norwegian Dream* and embark on our Baltic adventure!

Ports of Call

Warnemunde - Once considered just a quaint fishing village at the mouth of the Warnow River, Warnemunde emerged in the 20th century as Germany's fifth largest maritime center for all of Germany's shipping, shipbuilding and fishing industries. This port city is also the gateway to the great city of Berlin and its history, culture and attractions such as the restored Brandenburg Gate and Reichstag, and the Unter den Linden Strasse, a sweeping tree-lined shopping venue full of boutiques, galleries, and a wide variety of gift shops.

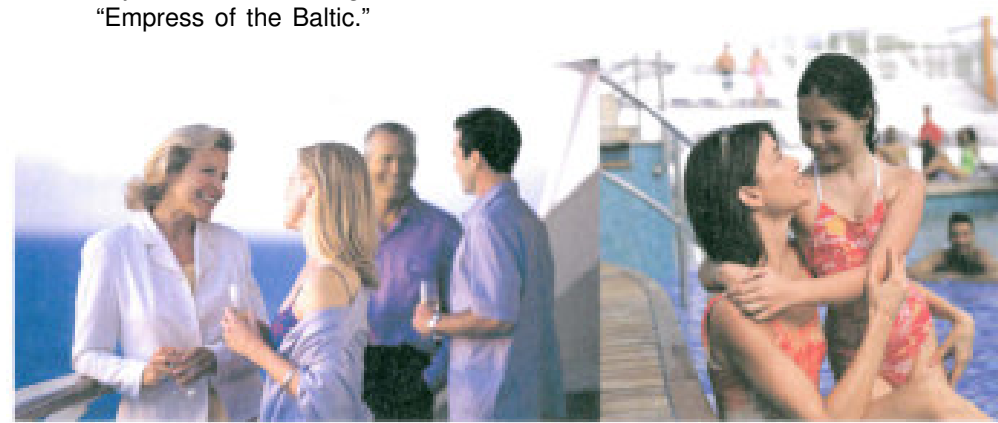
Tallinn - The beautiful capital city of Tallinn, situated on the Gulf of Finland, is one of the Baltic's great surprises, a fairyland jewel of medieval architecture perched dramatically above the sea. In 1991, Estonia won its independence from the Soviet Union without bloodshed, and since then, Tallinn has succeeded in restoring its beauty and charm. A member of the famed Hanseatic League that dominated trade in the Baltic during the Middle Ages, Tallinn has preserved its medieval Old City with its high church spires and red-tiled roofs.

St. Petersburg - Russia's second largest city and the supreme monument to the fantasy, boldness and sense of beauty of its people. Peter the Great founded it in 1703 to give Russia "a window looking on Europe." With its elegant palace-lined waterways, gilded and domed skyline, and grand boulevards where Czars once traveled in golden carriages, the majestic city of St. Petersburg well-deserves its nickname as the "Empress of the Baltic."

Helsinki - The capital and cultural center of Finland. The city is built on a peninsula and surrounded by hundreds of islands, while the skyline features a dramatic blend of classical architecture and clean modernism, with Russian and Swedish influences throughout. At seven every morning, most of the population appears to converge on the market square, where fresh fish, fruit and flowers are delivered by horse-drawn carts.

Stockholm - The capital of Sweden is beautifully set on a cluster of islands linked by boats and graceful bridges, from which there's a dazzling display of churches, palaces and museums. Explore Gamla Stan, or Old Town. Shop at NK, Stockholm's famous department store and sample the local smorgasbord. Sweden's center of art and culture, Stockholm is also famous for being the home of the Nobel Prize.

Copenhagen - Dotted with palaces, castles and churches, Copenhagen is a city of architectural beauty. Wander through some of the city's great museums such as the National Museum of the Glyptotek, with its radiant Gauguins. See the Crown Jewels in the Amalienborg Palace, home of the Danish Royal Family and the Royal Guard. Enjoy the shops, cafes and amusements of the Stroget, the world's longest pedestrian mall. Stop and smell the flowers at world-famous Tivoli Gardens, and explore the colorful Nyhavn district, a much-painted and photographed area along a picturesque canal dotted with boats.

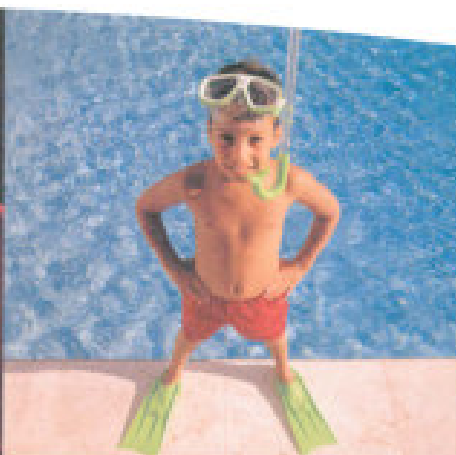

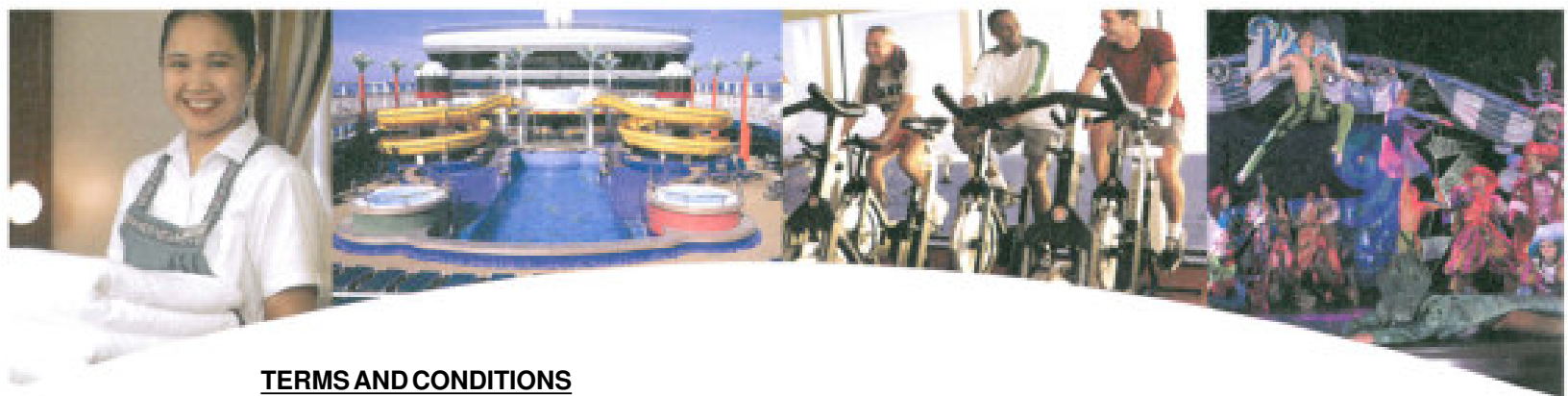

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

AIR ARRANGEMENTS: Add-on airfare from countless destinations across the U.S. and Canada are available. Should you prefer a departure city other than San Francisco, please contact our office for pricing.

NOT INCLUDED IN CRUISE PRICE: **Airfare; port charges, transfers, pre-cruise London package; government fees & air taxes;** shore excursions, lunches and dinners in London, Travel Protection Program, tips while aboard ship, passport fees, items of personal nature, etc.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All United States citizens must carry a valid passport as proof of citizenship.

PAYMENT: Payment can be made by cash, check or credit card (Discover, MasterCard or Visa). A deposit is required at the time of booking. Final payment is due upon receipt of final invoice (approximately 12 weeks prior to departure).

CANCELLATION: In event of cancellation, there will be a fee of \$75 for Dehoney Travel, Inc. to cover administrative costs. In addition, without protection as outlined on the following page, cancellation fees **will be charged**. Cancellation penalties are as follows: after booking until 95 days prior to tour, \$75 administrative fee; 95-51 days prior to tour, deposit is non-refundable; 50-13 days prior to tour, 75% of total tour cost; 12 days prior to tour-day of departure/no show, tour cost is non-refundable. **All cancellation notifications must be made in writing to Dehoney Travel, Inc. Please allow 4 weeks for cancellation refund processing.**

After ticketing of air fare, a cancellation penalty of 100% of the air fare is in effect. On or after the date of departure there can be no refund for any service not used.

TRAVEL PROTECTION PLAN: As many U.S. health carriers do not provide benefits while outside the mainland and cancellation penalties can be substantial for many tours, Dehoney Travel recommends the purchase of Access America travel protection. In order to maximize the value of your coverage, we recommend this purchase be made at time of deposit. **You may decline the Travel Protection Plan. To do so, a signed disclaimer is required and all cancellation charges are your responsibility.**

CANCELLATION, DELAY OR DEVIATION OF CRUISE: Carrier may at any time, without notice, delay, change or cancel the cruise or Commencement date, deny Passenger a stateroom or substitute vessels, even if Passenger has a confirmed or guaranteed reservation, and Passenger shall have no claim against Carrier/Dehoney Travel, Inc. for any resulting hotel, food, travel or other expenses, delay, inconvenience or damages whatsoever, other than reimbursement of unearned cruise/vacation package fare. This reimbursement discharges Carrier/DTI from all liability. If, after sailing, the cruise is interrupted by a fortuitous event, Act of God or any other cause for which neither the Carrier/Dehoney Travel, Inc. nor the Passenger is responsible, or the ship is or will be unduly delayed or prevented from proceeding in the ordinary course, Carrier shall have the right to terminate the ship's cruise, and refund the unearned cruise/vacation package fare. In all such cases, unless otherwise stated herein, the Passenger shall not be entitled to any refund of fare or compensation of any kind and shall have no other claim against the Carrier/Dehoney Travel, Inc. In all situations the ship may tow and assist vessels and deviate from the advertised route and call on or omit calling on any port or place for any reason or purpose which, in the Carrier's judgment, is reasonable under existing circumstances, and to comply with all orders given by governmental authorities, the underwriters of the ship or the Carrier. Passenger shall have no claim whatsoever against Carrier/Dehoney Travel, Inc. in such circumstances.
